

SUNY Potsdam/Union Graduate College Articulation Agreement

Union Graduate College provides two highly selective programs that prepare students for leadership in business:

- MBA - accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB)
- MBA in Healthcare Management - accredited by the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) and the Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Management Education (CAHME)

Union Graduate College has established an articulation agreement with SUNY Potsdam that allows students to complete their MBA degree in about one additional year after completing their undergraduate program. Students must complete the SUNY Potsdam courses listed below with a grade of B- or above to waive the Union Graduate College equivalents.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Juniors (Early Admission):

- 2nd Semester of junior year require a GPA of ≥ 3.4 and GMAT of ≥ 600

Seniors (And alumni)

- GPA of ≥ 3.5 may waive the GMAT for admission
- Recommended regular admission requirements are \geq GPA of 3.0/ \geq GMAT of 500

NOTE: The GMAT is required if you wish to be considered for a scholarship.
