### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

<b>First Degree Requirements</b>	Admission to one of the engineering programs is based on post-secondary academic achievement and intellectual promise, career goals, potential contribution to the college community, and personal recommendations. Requirements: Bachelor Degree (four year)
<b>TOEFL Score</b>	Minimum of 550 (213 computer based) Non-U.S. applicants who have not studied for at least two years in an English-speaking program must also submit an official score from the Test of English as a Foreign Language. A score of 600 (250 computer based) is preferred.
